The Tree of Life

Did you know that a growing person is like a tree?

In our minds, we are like a tree!

We can then **learn about spiritual things** -- things about the Lord and heaven. This is **like the flowers on a tree.**

And finally, we can take all that we've learned, and we can **do good and kind things for the world and for other people**. This is like the **fruit on a tree**.

The Lord is the one who creates our minds so we can do these things.

There is a very special tree mentioned in two places in the Word: once in the very beginning, in the book of Genesis, and once at the very end, in the book of Revelation.

The most beautiful tree in the whole Garden of Eden. This tree was in the middle of the Garden of Eden.

Because the Tree of Life represents something very, very important.

It represents **knowing that everything comes from the Lord**, even our own lives and hodies.

It's actually the most important thing there is to know. It's something that **needs to be in the middle of our minds**, just like the Tree of Life was in the middle of the Garden of Eden.

If only people could believe and remember that **everything comes from God!** Then the whole world would be a beautiful, peaceful place again, with no wars and no dangers.

At the end of the Word, in the book of Revelation, the Lord promises that that can happen again. When the disciple John was on the island of Patmos, the Lord showed him many amazing visions, and the last vision was the vision of the Holy City. Listen to this part, describing something inside the city: "In the middle of its street and the river, and on either side,

was the Tree of Life, which bore twelve fruits, yielding its fruit every month. And the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations." Revelation 22:2

The Lord was promising that a happy, peaceful, beautiful life can come to anyone who turns to God, and who knows **all good things** that they do **come from God**, and who tries hard not to do or wish evil things.
