### THE PILLARS OF NEW CHURCH BELIEFS



#### Love is Life

Swedenborg's description of love begins with a simple supposition; that love is, in fact, life itself, and that without love we would simply cease to exist.

Continuing a series about our beliefs in plain English.

This time we're looking at **OUR RULING LOVE** 

We love very many things and there are some things we might hate. We might love a piece of music or a particular colour or view from a ridge. We might love our family or a very close friend. We might hate injustice or deception. These are <u>not</u> our ruling love - these are specific things which we treasure or spurn.

Our <u>ruling</u> love is the love that prompts all our other loves. It rules and directs them all. And basically, it will be either for what we call heaven or what we call hell. And it is very important to add that we aren't able to say that our ruling love is 'this' or 'that' but by what we turn towards or turn against in our decisions here, our ruling love comes to develop what it is, always under the care of the Lord.

The crucial point is that when our spirit is released from our body, when we 'die', our ruling love, whatever it is, will begin to carry us very much like a current or stream, and we will find ourselves drawn as a matter of course to the basic love that has led us and which we have allowed to lead us here, deep down.

Perhaps that is a strong signal to us that things we leave unexamined or undealt with here doesn't seem to be a good thing.

Another thing about our ruling love after death is that anything which is not part of it just disappears from our perception and as far as we're concerned is no longer around. This happens so that we freely and gladly turn towards what we do love, whatever that is.

Just be aware of this teaching. Don't try and work it out too much. Don't get caught up in worrying what your ruling love might be! If you know what is of God and what makes heaven, then concentrate on that as your life's desire and goal. And that is a healthy thing to do.

As natural love can ascend by degrees and become spiritual and celestial, in the same way it can descend by degrees and become sensual and corporal; and it does descend so far as it loves dominion, from no love of use, but solely from love of self.

After an arduous time at the Hospital in Sydney, which included a minor seizure, Zachary and the family finally came home, with loads of medications to take 3 times a day. After 16 months off school, in July last year Zachary returned to school and has done well catching up. He has now returned to cricket as well. At the same time Zachary returned to school, his Father (who had become his full time carer during all of this) has returned to work.

Delightfully, a year after the transplant, Zachary had a bone marrow biopsy, and the results were clear. The family is now awaiting the next test in a year's time. Only then will it be considered that he is officially "cured". His Mum, Hazel, says that Zachary seems healthy now and they continue to be positive. For those who may be unaware, it was Christmas 2015 that our Church made a donation to help the family.
