

Unto us a Child was Born

Jesus was born in Bethlehem

In the historical account of the nativity we read that the Lord was conceived of the holy spirit in the womb of a virgin named Mary and by this means born into the world. Born in a manger, as there was no room at the Inn

God is the Lord, who, in the fullness of time was born into the world. The literal sense of the Word states in numerous places that it was Jehovah Himself that was born into the world and that this manifestation of the Divine is what is called the Son of God. This can be seen from the following...

The Lord Himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name "God with us". Is 7:14

It shall be said in that day, Lo, this is our God; we have waited for Him, and He will save us; this is Jehovah; we have waited for Him, we will be glad and rejoice in His salvation. Is 25:9

For the glory of Jehovah shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together. Behold, the Lord Jehovih will come with a strong hand, and His arm shall rule for Him... behold, His reward is with Him. Is 40:3, 5, 10, 11.

Unto us a Child is born, unto us a Son is given: and the government shall be upon His shoulder: and His name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, God, Hero, the Everlasting Father, the Prince of Peace. Is 9:6-7.

Reading: Deut 6:4-9; John 14:6-11; TCR 167

Deu 6:4-9 Hear, O Israel, Jehovah our God is one Jehovah. (5) And you shall love Jehovah your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your might. (6) And these Words which I am commanding you today shall be on your heart. (7) And you shall teach them to your sons, and shall speak of them as you sit in your house, and as you walk in the way, and as you are lying down, and as you are rising up. (8) And you shall bind them for a sign on your hand; and they shall be for frontlets between your eyes. (9) And you shall write them on the doorposts of your house, and on your gates.

Joh 14:6-11 Jesus said to him, I am the Way, and the Truth, and the Life. No one comes to the Father except through Me. (7) If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also; and from now on you do know Him, and have seen Him. (8) And Philip said to Him, Lord, show us the Father, and it is enough for us. (9) Jesus said to him, Am I so long a time with you, and you have not known Me, Philip? The one seeing Me has seen the Father! And how do you say, Show us the Father? (10) Do you not believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in Me? The Words which I speak to you I do not speak from Myself, but the Father who abides in Me, He does the works. (11) Believe Me that I am in the Father is in Me; but if not, believe Me because of the works themselves.

True Christian Religion (Chadwick) 167.

Everyone acknowledges that those three essentials, namely, soul, body and activity, were and are in the Lord God the Saviour. No one but Antichrist can deny that His soul was from Jehovah His Father; for in the Word, in both testaments, He is called the Son of Jehovah, the Son of the Most High God, the Only-begotten. So the Father's Divine is His first essential, as the soul is in man. It follows from this that the Son born to Mary is the body of that Divine soul, for what grows in the mother's womb is simply the body conceived and derived from the soul. So this is the second essential. Activities make up the third essential, since they are produced by the soul and the body workinIg together; and anything so produced is of the same essence as the productive agents. The three essentials, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, make one in the Lord, as the soul, body and activity do in man. This is plainly demonstrated by the Lord's saying that the Father and He are one, and that the Father is in Him and He is in the Father; likewise that He and the Holy Spirit are one, since the Holy Spirit is the Divine which proceeds out of the Lord from the Father.

The 175th Anniversary of the Adelaide Church

2019 is a big year for the Adelaide Church. Although it began in 1938 with the arrival of Jacob Pitman, William Holden, and Stephen Goldsack, all travelling to the new Colony of South Australia on the same ship; armed with books; services began on the ship sailing across. Then continued on arrival in Adelaide. Much history here! In 1844 the New Church became an Incorporated Association with the new SA Government Business Registrations.



From 27th April, throughout May, the SA Government holds a History Festival of early settlers, and how things have then progressed through the 1800's, 1900's to now. This Government History Festival was started in 2004 and has become quite an event. This is the first time that our Church is becoming a part of it. Much research is being carried out by Michael Delbridge, who helped with the 150th Church Anniversary. Also, June is planning and researching too, and we have a descendant Gt Gt Granddaughter of William Holden too, with lots of research. Rev. E.G. Day's descendants are in contact as well. There is a lot of preparation work currently underway. The SA Government are helping with advice, and one of the Organisers Workshop was attended this week by us.
